

CAMBRIDGE FARMER'S MARKET 2023 VENDOR AGREEMENT



Thank you for participating in the SNAP, Market Bucks, and Power of Produce programs at the Cambridge Farmer's Market! Please contact market management at cambridgefarmersmarketmn@gmail.com or 763-200-1398 for more information or if you do not understand any part of this agreement.

As a vendor participating in the SNAP and Market Bucks program, I agree:

- To accept the market's EBT tokens and Market Bucks only for SNAP-eligible food items (see page 2 for details)
- To charge the same price for goods whether a customer tenders EBT tokens, Market Bucks, PoP tokens, or other forms of payment that I normally accept
- That I will not give cash change in any amount for goods paid with EBT tokens, Market Bucks, or PoP tokens
- That I will not exchange EBT tokens, PoP tokens, or Market Bucks for cash for any reason

In addition, I understand that:

- It is important that I maintain accurate records of the tokens and Market Bucks I turn in to the market for reimbursement
- I will not be reimbursed for tokens or Market Bucks that were lost or that were not turned in to the market for reimbursement
- The market will not accept damaged or broken tokens for reimbursement
- The market will not reimburse me for tokens or Market Bucks at the market but will reimburse me by check around the 20th of each month for tokens and Market Bucks returned during the prior month; for example, tokens and Market Bucks returned in the month of July will be reimbursed around Aug 20th
- I will not accept for payment, and the market will not reimburse me for, tokens that were not issued by CFM with the CFM logo (see page 2 for details)
- I may only accept EBT tokens when the market is operational at 122 Buchanan St N, Cambridge, MN 55008
- It is my responsibility to ensure that anyone who sells at the market for my business understands and agrees to the terms of this agreement
- It is my responsibility to direct questions or concerns about the token/PoP program to the market manager should they arise
- I should notify market management beforehand if I choose to end participation in the program

By signing below, I agree to follow all rules in this Vendor Agreement as well as all federal regulations governing SNAP (CFR Title 7; Subtitle B; Chapter II; Subchapter C). I understand that if CFM staff observe or receive evidence of my failure to abide by this agreement, the market may suspend or terminate my approval to accept SNAP benefits, I may receive a monetary fine, and/or I may be dismissed from the market for the remainder of the season without refund of my vendor dues. I also understand that it is my responsibility to inform others of the rules and regulations outlined in this agreement before they may be allowed to sell on behalf of my farm or business.
